Stations Need to Update EAS Equipment to Accommodate Upcoming Changes

In November 2022, the FCC released a Public Notice announcing [changes in the distribution and operation](#) for improved EAS messages. As of December 12, 2023, all EAS participants must start transmitting EAS messages that are received in the IP-based format, when available. With the new rules, the FCC seeks to make EAS alert messages disseminated to the public by broadcasters and cable operators more informative and easier to understand.

NOTE: On October 4th about 1:20pm, there will be a national EAS Test. This will include cell phone alerts.



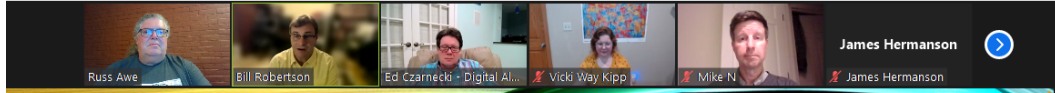
